REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS

Copies of the birth certificate, as well as any other legal documents regarding guardianship, must be presented at the time of registration.

RETURNING STUDENTS - VERIFICATION FORM

Students who were attending a Black Gold School Division (BGSD) school in 2025-2026 and are returning to a BGSD school in 2026-2027 are automatically registered for the 2026-2027 school year.

Please Note that Pre K students who will be attending Kindergarten are not automatically registered even if they attended a Black Gold school in the previous year. These students will need to register.

All BGSD families are expected to complete the Student Enrollment Verification Form for the 2026-2027 school year. In late August, parents/guardians will receive an email via SchoolMessenger with details on how to access this form during the first week of school.

EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES (ECS): KINDERGARTEN & PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

Kindergarten Program:

Full Days - Tuesday/ Thursday with an additional Wednesday class (1-2 per month beginning in October)

First day of Kindergarten is Thursday August 27th, 2026. The kindergarten teacher will email pre-registered families by August 21st to let them know their student's arrival time for the first day.

Students registered after June 26th, 2026 will have registration acknowledged by August 26, 2026.

School Doors open at 8:20 am each day

Morning Classes begin: 8:35 am

Lunch Break: 11:30 am - 12:10 pm

Dismissal Time: 3:05 pm

Kindergarten students will be dropped off and picked up at the east school doors.

Students riding the bus will be taken directly to/from the bus lane by staff.

Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten (EI-PreK)

Every child grows differently. Our Early Intervention Pre-Kindergarten (EI-PreK) provides specialized support for "little learners who need a little more" with communication, following directions, or social-emotional development. Available at Calmar Elementary, École Bellevue, École Corinthia Park, Linsford Park, Robina Baker, and Thorsby Elementary, our program helps children build the confidence and skills needed to thrive. Children may qualify as early as two years and eight months old (by August 31) if they meet eligibility criteria. Let us partner with you to give your child a strong start. English as an Additional Language (EAL) Junior Kindergarten:

Every child grows differently. Our English as an Additional Language (EAL) Junior Kindergarten is a social, play-based program for children whose main language at home is not English. Led by a certified teacher and an Educational Assistant, this program focuses on increasing vocabulary through play and building communication skills in a happy, supportive environment. Offered at École Dansereau Meadows School (Beaumont) and Willow Park School (Leduc), children may qualify as early as three years and eight months old (by August 31) if they meet eligibility criteria.
