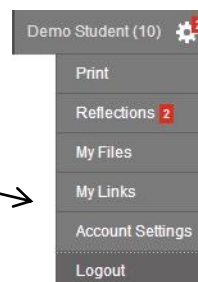

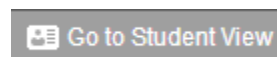
□ LINK WITH YOUR CHILD (Optional)
