Welcome back! We have had three days of successful staggered entry with students. The students have been great about following division and AHS health and safety protocols. We are working to keep students safe and in cohorts which are basically our homeroom classes.



We have about 25 students from WS opt to take their schooling via the Distance Education (DE) model. Given that these students are not working in our school building, staffing funding for those students has been moved over to the DE platform. Mr. Dykstra has been reassigned to the administrative team at the DE school along with two other Assistant Principals. In addition, half of Mrs. White's time has been allocated to the DE school, too. We are able to offer support to our students from Mrs. Sibley, Mrs. C. Swartz and Mrs. Parkyn.

So, because we have had to accommodate these personnel changes, we have had to redo our teacher assignments. A snapshot of our school:

All students have had an opportunity to enter and exit via their assigned doors. Now that we have had a trial run and because of where homerooms are located, we are making a small adjustment. Grade 10 students will now enter at the door nearest the main doors and the grade 9 students will enter at the HS Gym doors.

You're aware that our grade 7-12 students are permitted to leave the school campus during the lunch hours. If you would rather your child not leave the school grounds please send an

email to their homeroom teachers. We will encourage these students to get outside but stay within our school boundaries. Those students that leave the building must do their best to continue to maintain social distance and act in an appropriate manner in our community. We also don't want the students in and out during the lunch hour so unless the weather is terrible if they chose to be outside for lunch, they will stay outside for lunch.

Another reminder to parents and students that are driving to arrive at the school by 8:15. We would like these students to enter the building just before our bus students arrive. All doors are open at 8:15 and will remain open until our warning bell at 8:26 AM. If your child arrives after 8:26, please have them come to the main doors and we will let them in via those doors. We are all adjusting to the new schedule and it will take some time to get back into the routine being in school.

We were required to adjust our instructional time so we have revised our timetable/bell schedule. Here is a picture of that new schedule. As always, for this and other information, check out our school website, <u>ws.blackgold.ca</u>. Remember that we have early dismissal days on the first Wednesday of the month starting in October. We begin at the same time but students are dismissed at 2:21 PM.
