### **BUS CANCELLATION INFORMATION**

## **GENERAL**

Warburg School adheres to Black Gold School Division's policy on inclement weather, AP 132.

The information that follows is specific to Warburg School. Please forward any questions you may have about this information to either <u>Mrs. Maltais</u> or <u>Mr. Hodges</u>. As always, be in touch with your <u>child's teacher</u> if you have any classroom specific questions.

When buses are canceled the school remains open unless you are informed otherwise. If you bring your child to school, you are responsible for picking him/her up at the end of the day.

It is imperative that you call in to alert the <u>office</u> if your child will not attend during bus cancellation days. Student safety is of paramount importance and we want to ensure that those that either drove themselves or walked are accounted for at school. Call outs will be sent out for anyone marked unexcused.

When buses are canceled, all after school and extracurricular activities are canceled.

Take this time to look on PowerSchool to see your student's marks and what, if any, assignments are missing. Once in your Parent Portal you will note that the marks in each class are **BLUE**. By clicking on the blue mark, you will see which assignments make up this mark. Missing assignments will be noted with an

Students can always complete an assignment but will be subject to a % being deducted for late work. 50% is always better than 0%. Marks in Grades K-1-2-3 do look differently. Please check with your child's teacher about assignments that may be missing.

### **ELEMENTARY**

Generally, when so few students are in attendance, this time is used for catch up work and small group instruction. If your child's teacher uses Google Classroom, check online for assignments that may be posted.

## JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH

Class work in Jr/Sr high will continue. Timelines for content delivery are tight and instruction will take place. Students may attend classes in person or log on to their google accounts as ALL TEACHERS WILL BE ON A GOOGLE MEET FOR STUDENTS DURING THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED CLASS TIMES. **Students are expected to be online during their class time**. All assignments will be posted on Google Classroom. Assignments deadlines will be adhered to.

Students attending online will be marked Absent Excused with a note added in their attendance file that they have attended online. When we mark a student PRESENT, it means they are in the building. This is necessary for evacuation and emergency purposes.
